

Driving instructions to Güejar Sierra:



From the airport take the **A92G** and follow the white signs for Granada.

After about 12km you will see blue signs for the 'circunvalacion' **E902/A44**



You now need to follow the brown signs for 'Sierra Nevada' all the way to the village.



Take the first exit at the roundabout

At the turn of you should see this sign:





You will now need to take the **Ronda Sur** which is still sign posted for Sierra Nevada.

Shortly after you will approach a tunnel. Once in the tunnel get into the right hand lane, labelled 'Sierra Nevada'

As you come out of the tunnel bear right. Follow the sign to A395 'Sierra Nevada/Pinos Genil'.

You will be taking the first exit off this road just after you have passed the garage on the left 'zona de servicio'.

The exit is sign posted for 'Cenes de la vega/Pinos Genil/Guejar Sierra'. At the bottom of the ramp give way to the traffic and take a sharp left. You will then reach a t-junction where you turn right. From here the village is 10km.



Take the mountain road for 2km and look out for a road on the left sign posted to 'Guejar Sierra'.

This road will take you up the winding mountain road with the valley on your right. You will pass a sign welcoming you to Güejar Sierra next to a massive dam on your right. As you pass a Las Lomas camping sign prepare for a turning on the left.



Once you pass the campsite and the road turns to the right you will see a turning on your left. This has a few signs on it for: cementerio/barrio alto/la argumosa. At the top of this road you will come to a small square. Now the fun begins...



From the square take the first right the one with the steep slope warning sign! You will get used to these slopes...



Follow the road down and take the right fork past some white houses with garages towards the village. Keep on the main road past a square with parking on your right. Slow right down....

You need to take a sharp left turn up a narrow unmarked road....the one that looks like the picture here.

You will know it is the right one if you see a grey garage door straight ahead of you with 'cochera' painted on it.

Follow this little lane round to the right and you will see a green garage door at the end.



At the end of this little lane you will come to a junction where you need to turn left up a slope that then climbs a bit more to the right. The house is just off this road to the left.

Well done....now have a glass of tinto!
